

# Overseas Translation Workshop Program for 2016

LTI Korea organizes translation workshops at prestigious foreign universities with Korean literature or Korean studies programs to help foster and encourage potential translators of Korean literature. We are now accepting applications to the program for 2016.

## 1. Target Language\_ All languages

## 2. Number of Recipients\_ 4-6 universities

\* The number of recipients can differ depending on circumstances.

## 3. Eligibility

Universities with faculties who can guide the translation of the Korean short-story or poem into the target language and at least 5 students with sufficient proficiency in Korean to be able to translate it.

## 4. Grant Details\_ Faculty fees, Coordinator fees, Running costs

1) Funding to organize a translation workshop in which students meet once a week for 3 months to translate a Korean short-story or poem.

2) Funding to invite the author of the story/poem to participate in a 2~3day translation session with the participants of the workshop.

\* The university is responsible for planning and organizing the workshop.

Workshop will be held in second-half of the year 2016.

## 5. Grant Amount

- The university should specify the desired grant amount in its application. LTI Korea will decide the exact amount of the grant after reviewing the application

\* LTI Korea will also cover the writer's fees, and travelling and lodging expenses.

\* Countries using euro would be supported by euro, and the rest of the countries would be supported by dollars.

## 6. Required Documents

1) An official application form, in either Korean or English, and containing detailed information about the desired grant amount, the workshop's schedule, the overseeing department, participating students, and the writer and the story to be translated.

\* Stories/poems that have been previously translated into the target language cannot be used for the workshop. The story/poem may be changed at a later date with prior permission from LTI Korea.

2) Resumes and personal statements of the participating faculties in either Korean or English (no set format)

\* Submitted documents will not be returned.
